The points of interest to be raised:

Perdana Petroleum Bhd
It was reported that Perdana has formulated a strategic plan to regularise its public shareholding spread to maintain its listing status on Bursa Malaysia with the support of Dayang.

Could the Board explain how this could be done taking into consideration that as at 31 March 2017, Dayang still has a sizeable 98.014% shareholding in Perdana?

## Taliworks Corporation Bhd

Three different scenarios were considered on the timing of collection to determine the provision for discounting on the amount due from SPLASH.Could the Board outline the assumptions used in the 3 scenarios and the reasons supporting for each scenario?

Puncak Niaga Holdings Bhd

The Construction segment recorded a loss of RM151.4 million in FY2016 as compared to a loss of RM8.4 million in FY2015 as reported on pages 196 and 197 of the Annual Report. Could the Board explain the selection process of subcontractors? How would the Board ensure that such incidence does not occur in the future? What actions have the Board taken against this subcontractor?

Lafarge Malaysia Bhd

The Group launched its 2016 Sustainability Development Plan, known simply as the 2030 Plan that highlighted four key areas, namely climate, circular economy, water and nature, people and communities. What are the key challenges and risks facing the cement industry amid competition and tough market conditions upon implementing the 2030 Plan on sustainable practices into the business model to complement and be a key driver for growth in the group?
